greenberg s language universals is typical of his typological theoretical work in its stunning originality starting out from

the observations underlying praguian markedness greenberg contributes a mass of new data and generalizations and lays the foundations for a post structuralist usage based theory of grammatical asymmetries this work will continue to be influential for many years to come
